Firehouse (1 Long Pond Rd.) with only essential members of the board of fire commissioners, fire district officials and fire district chief officers.

All meetings of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Lake Shore Fire District are open to the public, however, in accordance with Executive Order 202.1 of 2020 issued by Governor Andrew Cuomo in response the Coronavirus COVID 19 crisis, the public will not be permitted to enter the Fire District building and instead the meeting will be opened to the public by means of remote audio access by placing a telephone call to 1-408-418-9388, using access code 132-677-7678 and password 32823582.

This access code will permit the public to listen, but not to comment as this procedure complies with the Open Meeting Law as temporarily suspended and amended by the Executive Order. Any member of the public will have an opportunity to submit questions and or comments to the Board of Fire Commission prior to the June 8, 2020 meeting in the form of a message on the ([www.lsfld.us](http://www.lsfld.us)) webpage under the **(CONTACT US SECTION)** no later than **12:00pm on Monday, June 8, 2020.**

If any member of the public after listening to the audio broadcast of the meeting wishes to submit a comment, he or she may do so by sending the comment in the form of a message on the ([www.lsfld.us](http://www.lsfld.us)) webpage under the **(CONTACT US SECTION)**. Any such comments will be considered as correspondence at the next meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners.
